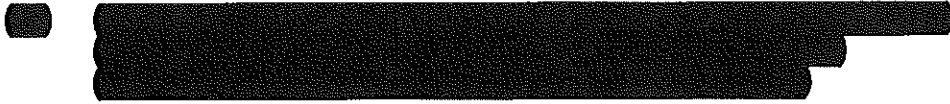
IV. AIR PIRACY OR THEFT OF AIRCRAFT AT OTHER AIRPORTS
