### CORRECTIONAL FACILITY DISTURBANCE

#### I. POLICY

Handling disturbances at correctional facilities is primarily the responsibility of the state Department of Public Safety. The Honolulu Police Department may provide assistance when it is requested.

#### II. RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. District commands shall establish and maintain plans to provide preliminary outside perimeter assistance at facilities within their boundaries.
- B. The Specialized Services Division shall coordinate and be in command of police assistance at correctional facility disturbances.

#### III. POLICE RESPONSE

- A. The Specialized Services Division shall be notified immediately by the Communications Division when a request for police assistance to a correctional facility disturbance is received.
- B. The responsible district command shall evaluate the situation, establish a temporary command post, and make appropriate outer perimeter assignments.

- C. Upon arrival at the scene, the Specialized Services Division commander shall confer with the patrol officer in charge and then assume command of police activities.
